Minutes: Marion read the minutes from the January 14, 2025 meeting; called for errors or omissions:

Treasurer's Report: Susan presented two months of reports: December 2024 and January 2025. She circulated a hard copy report of the Year End Financial Statements 2024. This report needs to be audited prior to the March Annual General Meeting (AGM). Louise volunteered to review the report.

2024 Month End December:

Chequing Opening Balance was \$3,123.27; Closing Balance \$1,747.64. Income: sale of \$64 from Calendars.

Expenses included: interest \$4.75, \$82.75 to Donna Christmas Party groceries, printing Calendars (Target Printers) \$672, Club HCBC Membership Renewal \$103.55, Acera Insurances (General Liability and D&O Liability) \$544.18.

Savings Account was \$6,075.74, after accounting for interest income of \$6.68.

2025 Month End January:

Chequing Opening Balance was \$1,747.64; Closing Balance \$1,797.89.

Savings Account closing was \$6,082.05 after \$6.31 interest earned

Marion submitted a receipt for renewing the Post Office Box for NHMHA for reimbursement: Susan issued cheque #1036 for \$196.35.

Two memberships were submitted: Louise and Garnet.

Susan has suggested we transfer some funds from chequing to savings.

Old Business

High on Ice, February 14 – 17, 2025: High On Ice Planning is still on track, pending weather. Donna provided an update after having met with Dave from City of FSJ, with Helen (VP for Ride for Disabled) and from scouting the Kin Park grounds. Julius had also scouted the routes. Donna worked with Lana, from Ride for Disabled to produce a detailed map has been drawn and was distributed at the meeting. It outlined the areas where we will stage the rides (the school parking lot), the heated washrooms

we have access to, the loading/unloading areas, and the routes. Donna said she was waiting for Dave to get back to her about the parking lot area for the horses. Other items were outlined:

- Lana informed that they have a heated trailer for volunteers to warm themselves in, and it will be staged in the parking lot on Friday night to prep for the weekend.
- Bev will bring a sandwich board for loading and unloading rules
- there is an icy spot at the end of the top trail; Dave will address it
- Lana is having tables with food/soup and buns; potluck will be welcome. Marion will pick up goodies from Tim Hortons. Donna will bring a box of prepackaged chips/snacks
- Horse manure will be cleaned up (Marion to bag it in feed sacks for removal)
- There is no fire ring or tent. Ray offered to bring his propane firepit but Lana said the City doesn't want the firepits on site.

Calendar 2025: Louise mailed out the calendars from last meeting and submitted a receipt of her cost outlay for reimbursement. Marion said there are still a few remaining calendars.

Year In Review 2024 draft Report: No changes were put forward to the draft report. It will be finalized as part of the content for the AGM in March.

Christmas Party planning 2025: No discussion

2025 Spring WagonTrek:

Julius will check with the Doig Pasture contacts to secure our spring wagon trek event. A notice will come out afterwards as well as a date for trail cleanup weekend.

Driving Clinic: planning will be started later this spring, with a potential for April as a target, if indoors, or later if outdoors. Most likely to be held at Julius's.
